(1 November)

## **THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED (ALL SOULS)**

(2 November)

Today and throughout the rest of November we pray for those who have died. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.

(22 November)

## **ADVENT**

(Begins 29 November)

Advent means 'coming'. We think of the coming of Jesus when he was born but we also think of his promise that he would come again at the end of time. It is a time of waiting and preparing. It is only in the last week of Advent that we focus upon the events to be celebrated at Christmas.

## **THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

(8 December)

This feast marks the first stage of the existence of Mary, the mother of Jesus. She was 'full of grace' from the very beginning and co-operated with God throughout her life.

This term we will be studying the three themes of Domestic Church (Family), Baptism and Confirmation (Belonging) and Advent and Christmas (Loving). Each class will approach the themes through different topics. The children will also spend a week studying Judaism.

#### DOMESTIC CHURCH - FAMILY

29<sup>th</sup> August

Class 1	<b>MYSELF</b> – God knows and loves each one
Class 2	<b>BEGINNINGS</b> - God is present in every beginning
Class 3	<b>HOMES</b> - God's vision for every family
Class 4	<b>PEOPLE</b> – The family of God in Scripture
Class 5	<b>LOVING</b> - God who never stops loving

#### SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES

Make a collage using family photographs of all the significant family members—grandparents, parents, children, aunts, uncles etc. who show God's love.

Write underneath it  
**"We show God's love to one another."**

Include those who have died.

#### Other faith 22nd October

Pupils will study various aspects of Islam for one week. Ask them what they have been learning about.

#### BAPTISM AND CONFIRMATION - BELONGING

29<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER

Class 1	<b>WELCOME</b> – Baptism: A welcome to God's family
Class 2	<b>SIGNS AND SYMBOLS</b> - Signs and symbols in Baptism
Class 3	<b>PROMISES</b> - Promises made at Baptism
Class 4	<b>CALLED</b> – Confirmation: A call to witness
Class 5	<b>VOCATION AND COMMITMENT</b> - The vocation of priesthood and religious life

#### SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES

Talk to someone who has been to a Baptism and/or Confirmation about their memories of this celebration.

#### ADVENT/CHRISTMAS - LOVING

3<sup>rd</sup> December

Class 1	<b>BIRTHDAY</b> – Looking forward to Jesus' Birthday
Class 2	<b>PREPARATIONS</b> - Advent: preparing to celebrate Christmas
Class 3	<b>VISITORS</b> - waiting for the coming of Jesus
Class 4	<b>GIFT</b> – God's gift of friendship and love in Jesus
Class 5	<b>EXPECTATIONS</b> - Jesus born to show God to the world

#### SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES

Discuss with the children how your family welcomes visitors to your home.

Find out about some Christian symbols for Advent e.g. Advent wreath, calendar, Jesse tree.
