



From 1st September 2013, each primary school receives funding to help increase P.E. expertise and high quality teaching in learning in P.E. in school. This funding should be used to provide a lasting legacy and is currently secured until 2020. The funding is £8000 plus £5 per pupil: Total £8595

St Charles Catholic Primary School has bought into the following package being offered by the North West Leicestershire School Sports Partnership (NWLSSP). The cost of this was £4500 plus £5 per pupil which equates to £5095. The amount spent on the NWLSSP provides the following:
